Patients can be seen in one of 4 ground floor consulting rooms. We have a shared reception and waiting area with access to disabled toilets. There are a number of administrative rooms including a staff room/small kitchen.

Externally, the practice has a shared car park with 18 parking spaces, including 2 dedicated disabled spaces and 2 family friendly spaces. Patients can access the practice via a small ramp at the front entrance.
